4. Burnout is a central theme in the story. What moments stood out to you as turning points where things began to fall apart?
5. How did relationships influence Clo's decisions? Which relationship felt most significant regarding her growth?
6. The book focuses on ambition versus fulfillment. Do you think it's possible to have both, or does one usually come at the expense of the other?
7. When did you agree or disagree with Clo's choices? What would you have done differently in her position?
8. What did you think about the ending? Did it feel realistic and satisfying, or did you want something different?
9. If you could ask Clo one question after the story ends, what would it be?
